

# MISSIONS TRIP TO JAPAN

**October 6 - 17, 2011**



Dale Pugh, who has served as Int'l Coordinator for World Indigenous Missions, has invited me to join him on a missions-trip to Japan, October 6<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

We will be working together with a PAZ church planting team in Tokyo, doing outreaches in the streets, parks and a train station. We will also speak/perform at public schools, a University and different churches.

We also have the opportunity to go on a trip to Iwaki, a town directly affected by the tsunami in March, helping with the tsunami disaster relief and presenting the Gospel Message on the streets.

The total cost for the trip is approx. \$1300 per person (flight, lodging and ground expense). This is a step of faith, but I am excited and confident that God will supply everything we need.
